HTTrack is a [free](#) (GPL, libre/free software) and easy-to-use offline browser utility.

It allows you to download a World Wide Web site from the Internet to a local directory, building recursively all directories, getting HTML, images, and other files from the server to your computer. HTTrack arranges the original site's relative link-structure. Simply open a page of the "mirrored" website in your browser, and you can browse the site

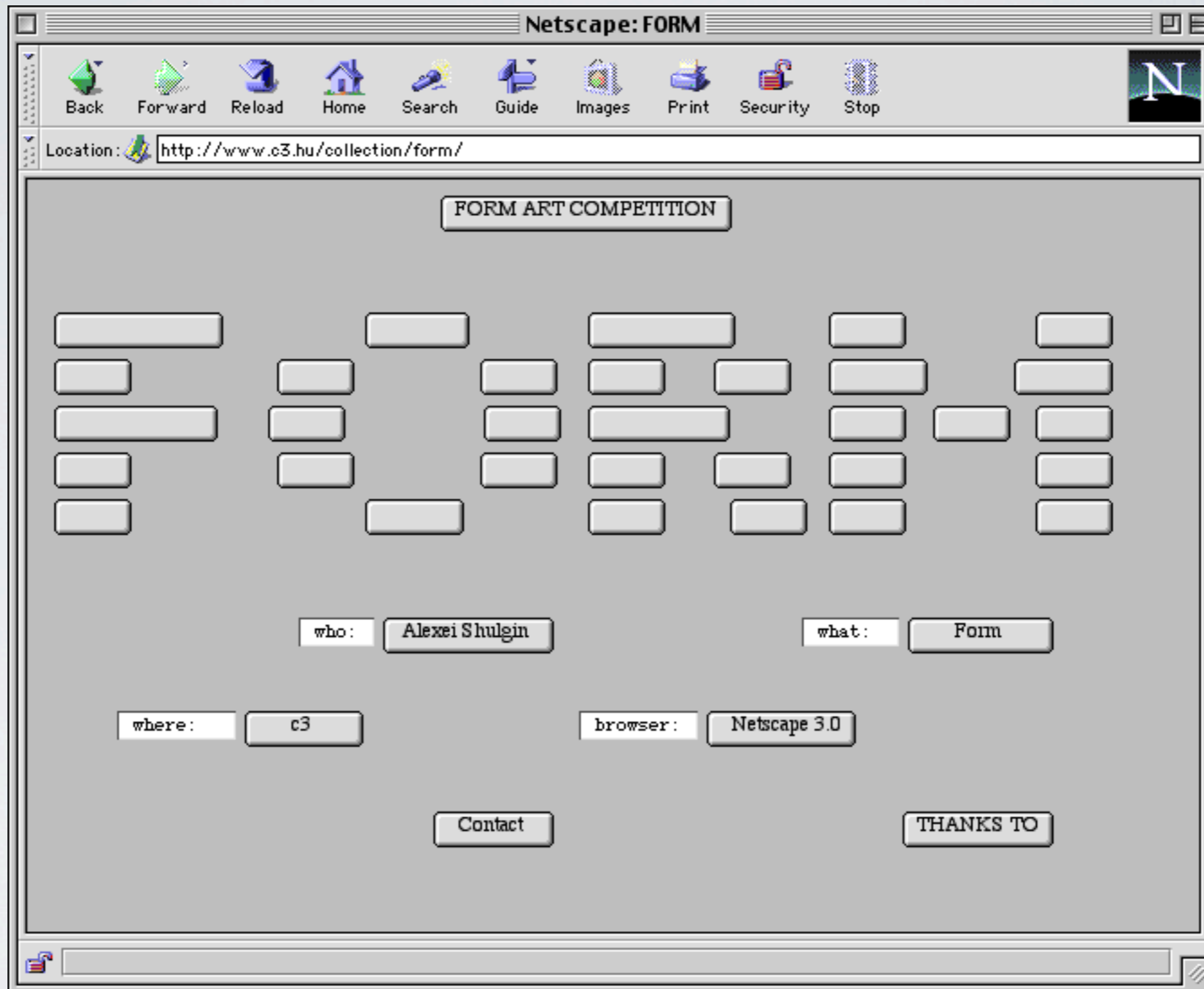
GNU Wget is a [free software](#) package for retrieving files using HTTP, HTTPS and FTP, the most widely
