



Sample dataset: crawl of the 108th U.S. Congress

Monthly snapshots, January 2003 to January 2005 1.15 TB gzipped ARC files 29 million captures of 7.8 million unique URLs 23.8 million captures are HTML files

Hadoop/HBase cluster:

16 nodes, dual quad-core processors, 3 × 2TB disks each

Warcbase Browser = Wayback Machine

Implementation

Lightweight HBase client embedded in Jetty app Reuses Wayback code for rendering







Topic modeling (LDA) on each temporal slice Adaptation of Termite visualization











